- 5. Latest Company printout from PACRA
- 6. Curriculum vitaes for new employees, certified copies of professional qualifications, copy of NRC
- 7. Proof of affiliation to Customs clearing agent Association
- 8. For Removals in Transit (RITs):
 - a) Letter of intent (Intending surety) confirmation letter/s or letter/s from guarantors intending willingness to provide security.
 - b) Proof of presence at entry and exit points through lease agreements or title deeds bearing Directors' details or Company Details
- 9. For Removals In Bond (RIBs):
 - a) Letter of intent (Intending surety) confirmation letter/s or letter/s from guarantors intending willingness to provide security.
 - b) Proof of ownership or occupancy of a customs area at each inland station where the applicant wishes to operate as a customs clearing agent.
